About Water Polo

A water polo team consists of 13 players, with only 7 allowed in the water at any one time (1 goalkeeper and 6 outfield players), however, substitution can occur at any time in the game. Play is four quarters of eight minutes actual playing time, which means a game lasts for about an hour. Similar to Basketball, teams have 30 seconds possession in which to score, ensuring a fast, exciting game.
