



CODE OF CONDUCT

Please read this Code of Conduct and return the associated form (PLAYER ACCEPTANCE & PAYMENT FORM) signed to show that you understand and agree to abide by it, retaining this copy for your own information.

1. GENERAL

This Code of Conduct lasts from arrival at Millfield School until dismissal by the Academy Director on Friday 10th August 2007.

2. CURFEW

All Players are expected to be in their own houses by 9.30pm, in their own rooms by 10.00pm and with their lights out at 10.30pm, unless instructed differently by a member of staff.

3. ATTENDANCE

Attendance at every session is obligatory. It is recognised that there may be exceptional circumstances for a player failing to attend, such as illness, and these must be reported to a member of staff as soon as possible. It is the decision of the Academy Director as to whether or not such circumstances are accepted and this decision is final.

4. PUNCTUALITY

Every player is expected to attend at the appointed time and be ready to commence each session, whether it is a training session, meal, workshop or meeting. Lateness will not be tolerated as it disrupts the session and is unfair on those members of the Academy who make the effort to be on time. Exceptional circumstances must be reported to a member of staff.

5. BULLYING

This will not be tolerated in any form, whether it is physical, psychological and or verbal. Any player who believes they have been subjected to such conduct should inform a member of staff as soon as possible and in the strictest confidence.

7. DISCRIMINATION

This will not be tolerated in any form, whether it is racial or sexual. Any player who believes they have been subjected to such conduct should inform a member of staff as soon as possible and in the strictest confidence.

8. POLITENESSES AND GENERAL CONDUCT

Politeness is expected at all times to your fellow players, Academy Staff and Millfield Staff. A player's conduct will be seen as a reflection not only on themselves but also the Academy as a whole. Players are expected to respect the property, buildings and grounds of Millfield School. If you bring your own ball with you it must be clearly marked with your name and left at the pool during the Academy.

9. ALCOHOL

Players are not permitted alcohol at the camp under any circumstances.

10. MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones are not permitted at the camp under any circumstances. Players will be given access to a phone should there be an emergency and should therefore bring change for a public phone to contact home during the week.

11. TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

All facilities at Millfield are within a short walk of each other and, unless players are informed otherwise, travel between them will be accompanied by a member of staff. Accommodation as allocated by the Academy Director must be used and it is the responsibility of the player to pay for any damaged caused. Players will not be allowed out of the confines of Millfield School without a member of staff and the prior consent of the Academy Director.

12. PERSONAL APPEARANCE

This shall be appropriate to the circumstances and as indicated by the Management Team.

13. ITEMS NOT COVERED

The Management Team reserve the right to alter any part of this code of conduct and to decide on any matters not covered. Players will be kept fully informed of any changes.

The failure on the part of any Player to comply with all of the code of conduct will result in one verbal warning by the Academy Director. Continued failure to comply will result in their dismissal and permanent exclusion from the Academy and may jeopardise their inclusion in any future Water Polo programme of this nature.

Should any player be permanently excluded from the Academy it is the responsibility of parents or guardians to collect them from the camp.
